FOUNDATION SKILLS ASSESSMENT Technical Guide for Adjudicators

This document describes how to access online Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA) tests using Windowsbased devices and Chromebooks. This information should be shared with staff overseeing FSA Tests at your school.

1) FSA's ON WINDOW DEVICES

Students using school Windows workstations to access the FSA tests need to log into the workstation using the generic account created for the school. The credentials are:

Username: ##fsa (where ## is the school number, e.g., 05 for George Jay, 13 for Oaklands). **Password**: fsa

The generic accounts are locked down to prevent access to drives, network shares and websites. The desktop has three shortcuts: 1) Field test for school technologists, 2) FSA Sample Tests, and 3) FSA Live Test.



2) FSA's ON CHROMEBOOK DEVICES

The procedure for using Chromebooks for FSA Exams is different from using PCs. Chromebooks are not locked down to prevent access to websites, drives, and network shares. **Extra supervision is required**. Both students with and without GAFE accounts can access the FSA online test using Chromebooks.

a) For Students with GAFE accounts:

Get the student to log into the Chromebook with their GAFE account (a.k.a. G-suite or sd61learn account). This will take the student straight to a web browser where they will see a "My School Apps" button on the upper left bookmark bar. Click on "My School Apps" and select "FSA – Sample Tests" or "FSA –Live Test".



b) For Students without GAFE accounts:

- 1. Login to the Chromebook as **Guest**. This will take you straight to a web browser with no personalization.
- 2. Type the FSA short link:
